Mabvuto Dyton is an orphan born into a family of three children. He joined Manna House in 2016 while he was 11 years old. He grew up in poverty. His life like many children in villages of Malawi was associated with farming and helping his mother do piece work for survival.

Despite these difficult circumstances of life, Mabvuto is an intelligent and well-mannered boy. His attitude toward school is just remarkable. He made sure he attended the after-school programs offered by the Manna House care center which are designed to help children with their school work.

After sitting for the grade 8 national examinations in 2020, he has successfully graduated to one of the leading, historical, and prominent high schools in Malawi, Robert Blake National Secondary school. His achievement was not just celebrated by family members but also the whole community. He becomes the first boy in his village to get selected to such an elite high school.

This success story of Mabvuto would not have been a possible if Manna House Ministry had not been available to him. Since 2016, Mabvuto has been participating in Manna House programs. He has been receiving school supplies and uniforms, a daily hot meal, and daily bible teaching. His presence at Robert Blake has been provided by Manna House Ministries through the contributions of our supporters. This child would not have been able to walk the corridors of Robert Blake without that support.
